Freeze the cells in a cryoprotective medium at -78°C.

Shipping Conditions

Store the cells at -78°C during shipping.

Storage Conditions

Store the cells at -150 to -196°C in a cryoprotective medium.

The cells are supplied in a sterile, cryoprotective medium. The medium contains PCR inhibitors. The cells are not tested for mycoplasma contamination.
